## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 16-5-94 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 restraining orders and protective orders, so as to provide that orders be served on a
- 3 respondent within 24 hours of the court's issuance of such order; to provide for related
- 4 matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Code Section 16-5-94 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to restraining
- 8 orders and protective orders, is amended by revising subsection (c) as follows:
- 9 ''(c)(1) Upon the filing of a verified petition in which the petitioner alleges with specific
- facts that probable cause exists to establish that stalking by the respondent has occurred
- in the past and may occur in the future, the court may order such temporary relief ex parte
- as it deems necessary to protect the petitioner or a minor of the household from stalking.
- 13 (2) If the court issues an ex parte order, a copy of the order shall be immediately
- furnished to the petitioner, and the clerk shall forthwith issue a summons and deliver it
- for service to the respondent within 24 hours of the court's issuance of such order."
