A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To repeal an Act entitled "An Act to repeal an Act entitled 'An Act to provide for a budget  
2 in all counties in this state having a population of two hundred thousand or more by the  
3 United States census of 1930, or by any future census; to define the word 'authorities' as used  
4 herein; for the publication of the proposed budget, the adoption of the budget and publication  
5 of the final budget as adopted... and for other purposes,' approved March 16, 1939, appearing  
6 in Georgia Laws 1939 pp. 272-276, and all Acts amendatory thereto; and for other purposes"  
7 approved March 2, 1953 (Ga. L. 1953, p. 2815), and all Acts amendatory thereto; to repeal  
8 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

9 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:**

10 **SECTION 1.**

11 An Act entitled "An Act to repeal an Act entitled 'An Act to provide for a budget in all  
12 counties in this state having a population of two hundred thousand or more by the United  
13 States census of 1930, or by any future census; to define the word 'authorities' as used herein;  
14 for the publication of the proposed budget, the adoption of the budget and publication of the  
15 final budget as adopted... and for other purposes,' approved March 16, 1939, appearing in  
16 Georgia Laws 1939 pp. 272-276, and all Acts amendatory thereto; and for other purposes"  
17 approved March 2, 1953 (Ga. L. 1953, p. 2815), and all Acts amendatory thereto, are hereby  
18 repealed.

19 **SECTION 2.**

20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
