## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Code Section 20-2-261 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to common minimum facility requirements for public elementary and secondary schools under the "Quality Basic Education Act," so as to provide for the inclusion of certain visual safety devices in minimum facility requirements; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

## 6 **SECTION 1.** 7 Code Section 20-2-261 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to common 8 minimum facility requirements for public elementary and secondary schools under the 9 "Quality Basic Education Act," is amended by revising subsection (a) as follows: 10 ''(a)(1) As used in this subsection, the term 'state minimum standard codes' shall have the 11 same meaning as in paragraph (9) of Code Section 8-2-20. 12 (2) The State Board of Education shall establish common minimum facility requirements 13 which each public school facility must meet in order to be certified for use in any 14 component of the educational or recreational program of that school. Such minimum 15 requirements shall include those provisions of law or state board policy on matters that 16 relate to:

17	(A) Fire fire and physical safety, including, but not limited to:
18	(i) Non-audio, visual displays, alarms, or other suitable devices installed at each
19	exterior door of a public school facility capable of clearly indicating to persons
20	located inside the facility within sight of such door that it is properly secured; and
21	(ii) Electronic message boards installed at critical locations within a public school
22	facility capable of displaying critical safety information to occupants of such facility;
23	(B) Sanitation sanitation and health, including temperature and ventilation;
24	(C) Minimum minimum space, size, and configuration for the various components of
25	the instructional program; and
26	(D) Construction construction stability, quality, and suitability for intended uses.
27	Such minimum requirements shall not prohibit wood construction that is otherwise in
28	compliance with state minimum standard codes as they existed on January 1, 2014. As
29	used in this subsection, the term 'state minimum standard codes' shall have the same
30	meaning as in paragraph (9) of Code Section 8-2-20."

## 31 **SECTION 2.**

32 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
