A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 1 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 general provisions for state government, so as to prohibit the state and its political
- 3 subdivisions from adopting policy recommendations that would infringe upon private
- 4 property rights without due process; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws;

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 Chapter 1 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general provisions for state government, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as

- 12 (a) The state or any political subdivision thereof shall not adopt or implement any policy
- 13 <u>recommendation that infringes upon or restricts private property rights without due process</u>
- of law even if required by recommendations originating in or traceable to a policy
- 15 <u>statement for sustainable development adopted in 1992 at the Conference of Environment</u>
- and Development by an organization composed of representatives of multiple nations or
- 17 <u>any other international law or plan of action that contravenes the Constitution of the United</u>
- 18 States or the Constitution of Georgia.
- 19 (b) The state or any political subdivision thereof shall not enter into any agreement,
- 20 <u>expend any sum of money, contract for services, or give or receive financial aid to or from</u>
- 21 any nongovernmental or intergovernmental organization enlisted by an organization
- 22 <u>composed of representatives of multiple nations engaged in the implementation of policy</u>
- 23 adopted in 1992 at the Conference of Environment and Development by an organization
- 24 <u>composed of representatives of multiple nations.</u>
- 25 (c) No contract in conflict with this Code section shall be entered into or renewed on or
- 26 <u>after its effective date."</u>
