A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To provide for a nonbinding, advisory referendum for the purpose of ascertaining whether
- 2 the General Assembly should enact legislation authorizing the City of Scotland to select its
- 3 mayor and city councilmembers to serve for four-year terms; to provide for legislative
- 4 purposes and findings; to provide for procedures and requirements relating thereto; to
- 5 provide for preclearance; to provide for related matters; to provide for a referendum and
- 6 effective dates; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 (a) It is the purpose of this Act to provide for a nonbinding, advisory referendum for the
- 10 purpose of ascertaining whether the General Assembly should enact legislation authorizing
- 11 the City of Scotland to select its mayor and city councilmembers to serve for four-year terms
- 12 instead of the current two-year terms.
- 13 (b) It is found, determined, and declared that the holding of the nonbinding, advisory
- 14 referendum provided for in this Act is:
- 15 (1) In all respects for the benefit of the people of the City of Scotland;
- 16 (2) A public purpose; and
- 17 (3) An essential governmental function for which public funds may be expended.

18 SECTION 2.

- 19 Unless prohibited by the federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended, the municipal
- 20 election superintendent of the City of Scotland shall call and conduct a nonbinding, advisory
- 21 referendum election as provided in this section for the purpose of submitting a question to
- 22 the electors of the City of Scotland to determine whether a majority of said electors want the
- 23 General Assembly to enact legislation authorizing the City of Scotland to select its mayor
- 24 and councilmembers to serve for four-year terms. The municipal election superintendent
- shall conduct that election on the Tuesday after the first Monday in November, 2013, and

13 LC 35 2929/AP 26 shall issue the call and conduct that election as provided by general law. The municipal 27 election superintendent shall cause the date and purpose of the election to be published once 28 a week for two weeks immediately preceding the date thereof in the official organ of Telfair 29 County. The ballot shall have written or printed thereon the words: 30 "NONBINDING ADVISORY REFERENDUM () YES Should the General Assembly enact legislation authorizing the City of 31 32 () NO Scotland to select its mayor and city councilmembers to serve for four-year terms?" 33 All persons desiring to vote for approval of the question shall vote "Yes," and all persons desiring to vote for rejection of the question shall vote "No." The expense of such election 34 shall be borne by the City of Scotland. It shall be the election superintendent's duty to certify 35 the result thereof to the Secretary of State and to each member of the General Assembly 36 whose senatorial or representative district lies wholly on partially within the City of Scotland. 37 **SECTION 3.**

The Scotland City Council shall through its legal counsel cause this Act to be submitted for 39 preclearance under the federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended; and such submission 40 shall be made to the United States Department of Justice or filed with the appropriate court 41 no later than 45 days after the date on which this Act is approved by the Governor or 42 43 otherwise becomes law without such approval.

44 **SECTION 4.**

- Except as otherwise provided in Section 2 of this Act, this Act shall become effective upon 45
- its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law without such approval. 46

47 **SECTION 5.**

48 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
