

The Senate Committee on Appropriations offered the following substitute to HB 611:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Part 1 of Article 4 of Chapter 12 of Title 45 of the Official Code of Georgia
2 Annotated, relating to management of budgetary and financial affairs, so as to provide for
3 the disposition of all funds paid to the state from legal settlements; to provide for related
4 matters; to provide for an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

7 Part 1 of Article 4 of Chapter 12 of Title 45 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
8 relating to management of budgetary and financial affairs, is amended by adding a new Code
9 Section to read as follows:

10 "45-12-76.1.

11 All funds paid to this state in accordance with legal settlements entered into by this state
12 or on its behalf on or after June 1, 2023, shall be held in the state treasury until
13 appropriated by the General Assembly, subject to, and in accordance with, any terms or
14 conditions contained in a judgment, settlement agreement, or memorandum of
15 understanding."
