## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 38 of Title 43 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 operators of private detective businesses and private security businesses, so as to revise the
- 3 practice of private detective business; to include the application of electronic tracking devices
- 4 within the definition of a private detective business for certain circumstances; to revise
- 5 requirements used by the Georgia Board of Private Detective and Security Agencies for
- 6 concealed weapons permit applications; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting
- 7 laws; and for other purposes.

## 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

9 **SECTION 1.** 

- 10 Chapter 38 of Title 43 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to operators of
- 11 private detective businesses and private security businesses, is amended by revising Code
- 12 Section 43-38-3, relating to definitions, as follows:
- *"*43-38-3.
- 14 As used in this chapter, the term:
- 15 (1) 'Board' means the Georgia Board of Private Detective and Security Agencies, a
- professional licensing board.
- 17 (1.1) 'Electronic tracking device' means an electronic or mechanical device that permits
- a person to remotely determine or track the position and movement of another person.
- 19 (2) 'Law enforcement agency' means an agency responsible for ensuring compliance with
- the laws and ordinances enacted by federal, state, and local governing authorities.
- 21 (3) 'Private detective business' means the business of obtaining or furnishing, or
- accepting employment to obtain or to furnish, information with reference to:
- 23 (A) Crimes or wrongs done or threatened against the United States of America or any
- state or territory thereof;
- 25 (B) The background, identity, habits, conduct, business, employment, occupation,
- assets, honesty, integrity, credibility, knowledge, trustworthiness, efficiency, loyalty,

activity, movement, whereabouts, affiliations, associations, transactions, acts,

- reputation, or character of any person;
- 29 (C) The location, disposition, or recovery of lost or stolen property;
- 30 (D) The cause or responsibility for fires, libels, losses, accidents, damage, or injury to
- 31 persons or property;
- 32 (E) The securing of evidence in the course of the private detective business to be used
- before any court, board, officer, or investigating committee; or
- 34 (F) The protection of individuals from serious bodily harm or death; or
- 35 (G) The application of an electronic tracking device, provided that such determination
- or tracking is not otherwise contrary to law and the person subject to the determination
- or tracking of the electronic tracking device is not under the protection of a protective
- order issued pursuant to Article 1 of Chapter 13 of Title 19.
- 39 (4) 'Private security business' means engaging in the business of, or accepting
- 40 employment to provide, any or all of the following:
- 41 (A) Private patrol service;
- 42 (B) Watchman service;
- 43 (C) Guard service;
- 44 (D) Armored car service; or
- 45 (E) The protection of persons from death or serious bodily harm."

46 SECTION 2.

- 47 Said chapter is further amended by revising subsection (e) of Code Section 43-38-10, relating
- 48 to permits to carry firearms, proficiency requirement, exemption from specified laws, denial,
- 49 refusal to renew, and suspension of permits, and effect of license suspension and restoration,
- 50 as follows:
- 51 "(e) Licensees or registrants under this chapter may apply to the board for a concealed
- 52 weapons permit. Qualifications and training requirements for such permits and restrictions
- on such permits shall be established by appropriate rules of the board and shall be
- 54 <u>consistent with the requirements of Code Section 16-11-129</u>. The board shall, in its
- discretion, consider and approve each application for a concealed weapons permit on an
- 56 individual basis."

57 SECTION 3.

All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
