A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 25 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
- 2 Georgia Technology Authority, so as to require such authority to study the potential
- 3 implementation of a state-wide unique identification system and a centralized website for all
- 4 businesses and legal entities; to provide for requirements and a report; to require cooperation
- 5 and collaboration; to provide for related matters; to provide for automatic repeal; to repeal
- 6 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Chapter 25 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the Georgia
- 10 Technology Authority, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 11 "50-25-17.
- 12 (a) The authority shall conduct a study to explore the potential implementation of a
- state-wide unique identification system and a centralized website for all businesses and
- legal entities. Such study shall include an analysis of:
- 15 (1) Any necessary legislative changes;

16 (2) Technical infrastructure needed to support such a system and website and any

- 17 <u>necessary interagency communications and data sharing;</u>
- 18 (3) Estimated time frame required for completion of such a system and website;
- 19 (4) Estimated costs and resources needed to implement and maintain such a system and
- website;
- 21 (5) Extent to which such a system and website would improve government services and
- 22 reduce the administrative burden on businesses; and
- 23 (6) Any other information the authority deems necessary and appropriate relative to the
- 24 <u>development and implementation of such a system and website.</u>
- 25 (b) Any relevant agency shall cooperate and collaborate with the authority as is necessary
- to complete the study required by this Code section.
- 27 (c) The authority shall submit a report of the study to the Governor, the President of the
- 28 Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, and the chairperson of the House
- 29 <u>Committee on Small Business Development no later than June 30, 2022.</u>
- 30 (d) This Code section shall stand automatically repealed on July 1, 2022."
- 31 SECTION 2.
- 32 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
