A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend an Act creating the Polk County Water Authority, approved April 14, 1967
- 2 (Ga. L. 1967, p. 3108), as amended, particularly by an Act approved May 18, 2007
- 3 (Ga. L. 2007, p. 3949), so as to change certain provisions relating to the appointment, taking
- 4 of office, and terms of office of members of the authority; to provide for related matters; to
- 5 repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 An Act creating the Polk County Water Authority, approved April 14, 1967 (Ga. L. 1967,
- 9 p. 3108), as amended, particularly by an Act approved May 18, 2007 (Ga. L. 2007, p. 3949),
- 10 is amended by revising subsections (d) and (g) of Section 2 as follows:
- 11 "(d) On and after April 1, 2007, upon completion of the respective terms of the members
- of the Authority appointed by the Grand Jury pursuant to subsection (c) of this section,
- each successor to the members appointed by the Grand Jury and all successors thereafter
- shall be appointed by the affirmative vote of four members of the Polk County Board of
- 15 Commissioners. The term of each person appointed by the board of commissioners
- pursuant to this subsection shall be for five years and until their respective successors are
- duly appointed and qualified; provided, however, that a member of the Authority may be
- 18 removed at any time upon the affirmative vote of four members of the Polk County Board
- 19 of Commissioners."
- 20 "(g) In the event of a vacancy by reason of death, disqualification, resignation, or other
- 21 reason, such vacancy shall be filled by the appointment by the affirmative vote of four
- 22 members of the Polk County Board of Commissioners of a qualified person for the
- 23 unexpired term of office."

SECTION 2.

25 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
