A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To amend Chapter 12 of Title 31 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to 2 control of hazardous conditions, preventable diseases, and metabolic disorders, so as to 3 authorize persons to wear masks, hoods, or other devices to prevent the spread of a 4 contagious or infectious disease during and for 12 months following the conclusion of a 5 public health emergency; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for 6 other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

9 Chapter 12 of Title 31 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to control of

hazardous conditions, preventable diseases, and metabolic disorders, is amended by adding
a new Code section to read as follows:

12 ″<u>31-12-15.</u>

13 During and for 12 months following the conclusion of a public health state of emergency

14 <u>declared by the Governor to prevent the spread of a contagious or infectious disease, no</u>

- 15 person shall be subject to prosecution under Code Section 16-11-38 for wearing a mask,
- 16 <u>hood, or device by which any portion of the face is so hidden, concealed, or covered as to</u>

- 17 conceal his or her identity if such person is wearing such mask, hood, or device for the
- 18 purpose of preventing the spread of such contagious or infectious disease."

19 SECTION 2.

20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
