A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 23 of Title 47 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
- 2 Georgia Judicial Retirement System, so as to repeal prohibitions against certain state court
- 3 judges of Fulton County participating in other public retirement systems; to provide for
- 4 related matters; to provide conditions for an effective date and automatic repeal; to repeal
- 5 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Chapter 23 of Title 47 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the Georgia
- 9 Judicial Retirement System, is amended by revising paragraph (17) of Code Section 47-23-1,
- 10 relating to definitions, as follows:

- 11 "(17) 'State court' means any court created pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 7 of
- 12 Title 15 or any court continued as a state court by Article VI, Section X of the
- Constitution of the State of Georgia; provided, however, that such term shall include the
- State Court of Fulton County subject to the provisions of Code Section 47-23-50."

15 SECTION 2.

- 16 Said chapter is further amended by revising Code Section 47-23-50, relating to retirement
- 17 benefits for state judges serving Fulton County, as follows:
- 18 "47-23-50.
- Any person who becomes a judge of the State Court of Fulton County on or after July 1,
- 20 2004, shall become a member of this retirement system by operation of law and shall not
- 21 be a member of any other public retirement system Reserved."
- SECTION 3.
- 23 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2024, only if it is determined to have been
- 24 concurrently funded as provided in Chapter 20 of Title 47 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 25 Annotated, the "Public Retirement Systems Standards Law"; otherwise, this Act shall not
- become effective and shall be automatically repealed in its entirety on July 1, 2024, as
- 27 required by subsection (a) of Code Section 47-20-50.
- SECTION 4.
- 29 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
