A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Chapter 3 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to 1 postsecondary education, so as to provide for a special institutional fee waiver for students 2 3 who work 20 or more hours per week as graduate assistants at units of the University System 4 of Georgia; to provide for a definition; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting 5 laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA: 6

7	SECTION 1.
8	Chapter 3 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to postsecondary
9	education, is amended by adding a new article to read as follows:
10	" <u>ARTICLE 13</u>
11	<u>20-3-680.</u>
12	(a) As used in this article, the term 'graduate assistant' means a student enrolled in a
13	postgraduate program at a unit of the University System of Georgia who works 20 or more

hours per week during an academic term in a graduate assistantship position, including, but 14

- 15 not limited to, the positions of graduate teaching assistant, graduate lab assistant, graduate
- 16 research assistant, and graduate research fellow assistant.
- 17 (b) The board of regents is directed to waive mandatory special institutional fees for
- 18 graduate assistants."

SECTION 2.

20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
