A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To amend Chapter 3 of Title 44 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to

- 2 regulation of specialized land transactions, so as to provide that certain information be
- 3 disclosed on the websites of condominiums and property owners' associations; to provide for
- 4 related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Chapter 3 of Title 44 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to regulation of
- 8 specialized land transactions, is amended in Code Section 44-3-80, relating to allocation of
- 9 liability for common expenses with regard to condominiums and how assessments are made,
- 10 by adding a new subsection to read as follows:
- 11 "(h) Each condominium that maintains an Internet website shall disclose on such website
- on a separate page of such website a listing of all fees that a purchaser of a condominium
- 13 <u>unit covered by such condominium instruments would expect to pay at closing on such unit</u>
- 14 to include, but not be limited to, closing letter fees, special assessments, initiation fees,
- move-in fees, and similar charges. Navigation to such web page shall be prominently
- displayed on the home page of such Internet website and such web page shall be readily
- 17 <u>accessible to potential purchasers."</u>

18 SECTION 2.

- 19 Said chapter is further amended in Code Section 44-3-225, relating to assessment of
- 20 expenses, exemption from liability, and liability for unpaid assessments for property owners'
- 21 associations, by adding a new subsection to read as follows:
- 22 "(e) Each property owners' association that maintains an Internet website shall disclose on
- 23 <u>such website on a separate page of such website a listing of all fees that a purchaser of a</u>
- 24 lot covered by such property owners' association would expect to pay at closing on such
- 25 <u>lot to include, but not be limited to, closing letter fees, special assessments, initiation fees,</u>

26	move-in fees, and similar charges.	Navigation to such	web page shall	be prominently
27	displayed on the home page of such	Internet website an	d such web page	shall be readily

28 <u>accessible to potential purchasers."</u>

SECTION 3.

30 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
