A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 80 of Title 36 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 counties, municipal corporations, and other governmental entities in general, so as to provide
- 3 for the completion and submission of annual audit reports by community improvement
- 4 districts; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Chapter 80 of Title 36 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to counties,
- 8 municipal corporations, and other governmental entities in general, is amended by adding a
- 9 new Code section to read as follows:
- 10 "36-80-24.
- 11 The administrative body of a community improvement district created pursuant to Article
- 12 <u>IX, Section VII of the Constitution of Georgia shall have an audit of accounts conducted</u>
- by an independent certified accountant. Such audit shall indicate revenues and
- 14 expenditures in sufficient detail to verify that the community improvement district met and
- complied with requirements of any governmental grants, loans, awards, or matching funds
- and shall be conducted within 120 days after the completion of the community
- 17 <u>improvement district's fiscal year.</u> No later than 150 days after the completion of a
- 18 <u>community improvement district's fiscal year, the administrative body of such community</u>
- 19 <u>improvement district shall submit a copy of the findings and audit report to the</u>
- 20 <u>commissioner of transportation, the chairpersons of the Senate and House of</u>
- 21 Representatives transportation committees, the chairperson of the Senate Government
- 22 Oversight Committee, and the chairperson of the House Committee on Budget and Fiscal
- 23 Affairs Oversight. This Code section shall govern over any conflicting provisions of any
- 24 <u>local Act or county or municipal ordinance.</u>"
