A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend an Act to provide a new charter for the City of Atlanta, approved April 15, 1996
- 2 (Ga. L. 1996, p. 4469), as amended, so as to provide for public safety access assessments;
- 3 to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 SECTION 1.

- 6 An Act to provide a new charter for the City of Atlanta, approved April 15, 1996
- 7 (Ga. L. 1996, p. 4469), as amended, is amended by revising subsection (c) of Section 1-102
- 8 by striking the period at the end of paragraph (61) and inserting in lieu thereof "; and" and
- 9 inserting a new paragraph to read as follows:
- "(62) For the protection of public health, welfare, and convenience of the city, and for
 the adequate provision of police, fire, and other emergency services, to fix and collect a
- public safety access assessment within the city. The collection of such public safety
- access assessment due the city shall be enforced by ordinance or resolution in the same
- manner as authorized by law for the enforcement of the collection and payment of state
- taxes, fees, or assessments. The public safety access assessment shall be deemed an
- additional source of municipal funding under subsection (j) of Code Section 46-5-134 of
- the O.C.G.A. and shall be expended by the city for the purposes of Part 4 of Article 2 of
- 18 Chapter 5 of Title 46 of the O.C.G.A. The amount of the public safety access assessment
- shall be recommended annually by the city's chief financial officer, subject to the
- approval of the city council, to provide sufficient revenue for operation of the city's 9-1-1
- 21 communications section. In no event shall the total public safety access assessment,

combined with the funds received by the city under Part 4 of Article 2 of Chapter 5 of

- Title 46 of the O.C.G.A., exceed the total reserve, capital, and operating costs of the city's
- 24 9-1-1 communications section."

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25 SECTION 2.

All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
