A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 12-8-39 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to waste  
2 management cost reimbursement fees and surcharges, so as to authorize host local  
3 governments to impose a surcharge for auto shredder residue at municipal solid waste  
4 facilities operated by private enterprise; to provide for a definition; to provide for related  
5 matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 Code Section 12-8-39 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to waste  
9 management cost reimbursement fees and surcharges, is amended by adding a new  
10 subparagraph to paragraph (1) of subsection (d) to read as follows:

11 "(D) When a municipal solid waste disposal facility is operated by private enterprise,  
12 the host local government is authorized and required to impose a surcharge of \$1.00 per  
13 ton or volume equivalent for auto shredder residue, in addition to any other negotiated  
14 charges or fees which shall be imposed by and paid to the host local government for the  
15 facility. For purposes of this subparagraph, the term 'auto shredder residue' means the

16 residue, after the removal of metals, from the shredding of automobiles and major  
17 household appliances."

18 **SECTION 2.**

19 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
