To amend Code Section 31-2-8 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to actions
 against certain applicants or licensees, so as to increase fine amount limits; to repeal
 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

SECTION 1.

6 Code Section 31-2-8 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to actions against
7 certain applicants or licensees, is amended by revising paragraph (6) of subsection (c) as
8 follows:

9 "(6)(A) Except as otherwise provided in subparagraph (B) of this paragraph, impose a
10 fine of up to \$2,000.00 per day for each violation of a law, rule, regulation, or formal
11 order related to the initial or ongoing licensing of any agency, facility, institution, or
12 entity, up to a total of \$40,000.00;

13 (B) Impose a mandatory fine of no less than \$5,000.00 for a violation of a law, rule,

14 regulation, or formal order related to the initial or ongoing licensing of a long-term care

- 15 facility which has caused the death of or serious physical harm to a resident in such
- 16 facility. For purposes of this subparagraph, the term 'serious physical harm' means an

17	injury which causes any significant impairment of the physical condition of the resident
18	as determined by qualified medical personnel;
19	(C) No fine may be imposed pursuant to this paragraph against any nursing facility,
20	nursing home, or intermediate care facility which is subject to intermediate sanctions
21	under the provisions of 42 U.S.C. Section 1396r(h)(2)(A), as amended, whether or not
22	those sanctions are actually imposed; or"

- 24 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
