A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Title 16 and Article 1 of Chapter 10 of Title 17 of the Official Code of Georgia
- 2 Annotated, relating to crimes and offenses and the procedure for sentencing and imposition
- 3 of punishment, respectively, so as to repeal certain provisions regarding sentencing of
- 4 defendants guilty of crimes involving bias or prejudice, notices for enhanced sentencing, and
- 5 enhanced sentencing; to provide for sentencing of defendants who are convicted of certain
- 6 crimes which target an individual due to such individual's race, religion, gender, gender
- 7 identity, sexual orientation, national origin, or physical disability; to amend Code Section
- 8 15-11-2 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to definitions for the Juvenile
- 9 Code, so as to provide for a cross-reference; to provide for related matters; to repeal
- 10 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

12 PART I

13 **SECTION 1-1.**

- 14 Title 16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to crimes and offenses, is
- amended in Code Section 16-5-20, relating to simple assault, by revising subsection (b) and
- 16 by adding a new subsection to read as follows:
- 17 "(b) Except as otherwise provided in subsections (c) through $\frac{h}{g}$ or subsection (i) of this
- 18 Code section, a person who commits convicted of the offense of simple assault shall be
- 19 guilty of punished as for a misdemeanor."
- 20 "(i) Any person who commits the offense of simple assault against an individual
- 21 <u>intentionally selected because of such individual's race, religion, gender, gender identity,</u>
- 22 <u>sexual orientation, national origin, or physical disability shall, upon conviction thereof, be</u>
- 23 punished as for a misdemeanor of a high and aggravated nature."

24 **SECTION 1-2.**

25 Said title is further amended in Code Section 16-5-21, relating to aggravated assault, by

- 26 revising subsection (b) and by adding a new subsection to read as follows:
- 27 "(b) Except as otherwise provided in subsections (c) through (k) (f) and (h) through (l) of
- 28 this Code section, a person convicted of the offense of aggravated assault shall be punished
- by imprisonment for not less than one nor more than 20 years."
- 30 "(1) Any person who commits the offense of aggravated assault against an individual
- 31 <u>intentionally selected because of such individual's race, religion, gender, gender identity,</u>
- 32 <u>sexual orientation, national origin, or physical disability shall, upon conviction thereof, be</u>
- punished by imprisonment for not less than three nor more than 20 years."

SECTION 1-3.

- 35 Said title is further amended in Code Section 16-5-23, relating to simple battery, by revising
- 36 subsection (b) and by adding a new subsection to read as follows:
- 37 "(b) Except as otherwise provided in subsections (c) through (i) (j) of this Code section,
- a person convicted of the offense of simple battery shall be punished as for a
- 39 misdemeanor."
- 40 "(j) Any person who commits the offense of simple battery against an individual
- 41 <u>intentionally selected because of such individual's race, religion, gender, gender identity,</u>
- 42 <u>sexual orientation, national origin, or physical disability shall, upon conviction thereof, be</u>
- punished as for a misdemeanor of a high and aggravated nature."

SECTION 1-4.

- 45 Said title is further amended in Code Section 16-5-23.1, relating to battery, by revising
- 46 subsection (c) and by adding a new subsection to read as follows:
- 47 "(c) Except as otherwise provided in subsections (d) through (l) (i) and (k) through (m) of
- 48 this Code section, a person who commits convicted of the offense of battery is guilty of
- 49 <u>shall be punished as for a misdemeanor."</u>
- 50 "(m) Any person who commits the offense of battery against an individual intentionally
- 51 <u>selected because of such individual's race, religion, gender, gender identity, sexual</u>
- 52 <u>orientation, national origin, or physical disability shall, upon conviction thereof, be</u>
- 53 punished as for a misdemeanor of a high and aggravated nature."

SECTION 1-5.

- 55 Said title is further amended in Code Section 16-5-24, relating to aggravated battery, by
- revising subsection (b) and by adding a new subsection to read as follows:

57 "(b) Except as otherwise provided in subsections (c) through (g) (h) of this Code section,

- a person convicted of the offense of aggravated battery shall be punished by imprisonment
- for not less than one nor more than 20 years."

- 60 "(h) Any person who commits the offense of aggravated battery against an individual
- 61 <u>intentionally selected because of such individual's race, religion, gender, gender identity,</u>
- 62 <u>sexual orientation, national origin, or physical disability shall, upon conviction thereof, be</u>
- 63 punished by imprisonment for not less than five nor more than 20 years."

SECTION 1-6.

- 65 Said title is further amended by revising subsection (b) of Code Section 16-7-22, relating to
- criminal damage to property in the first degree, as follows:
- 67 "(b) A person convicted of the offense of criminal damage to property in the first degree
- shall be punished by imprisonment for not less than one nor more than ten years; provided,
- 69 <u>however, that if such property was intentionally selected because of such property owner's</u>
- 70 race, religion, gender, gender identity, sexual orientation, national origin, or physical
- 71 <u>disability, upon conviction thereof, such person shall be punished by imprisonment for not</u>
- 72 <u>less than three nor more than ten years.</u>"

73 **SECTION 1-7.**

- 74 Said title is further amended by revising subsection (b) of Code Section 16-7-23, relating to
- 75 criminal damage to property in the second degree, as follows:
- 76 "(b) A person convicted of the offense of criminal damage to property in the second degree
- shall be punished by imprisonment for not less than one nor more than five years; provided,
- however, that if such property was intentionally selected because of such property owner's
- 79 race, religion, gender, gender identity, sexual orientation, national origin, or physical
- disability, upon conviction thereof, such person shall be punished by imprisonment for not
- 81 <u>less than two nor more than five years.</u>"

82 **SECTION 1-8.**

- 83 Article 1 of Chapter 10 of Title 17 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 84 procedure for sentencing and imposition of punishment, is amended by repealing in its
- 85 entirety Code Section 17-10-17, relating to sentencing of defendants guilty of crimes
- 86 involving bias or prejudice, circumstances, and parole, and designating said Code section as
- 87 reserved.

SECTION 1-9.

Said article is further amended by repealing in its entirety Code Section 17-10-18, relating to notification to seek enhanced penalty, and designating said Code section as reserved.

SECTION 1-10.

Said article is further amended by repealing in its entirety Code Section 17-10-19, relating to determination of defendant's guilt, object of the offense, and enhancement of sentence, and designating said Code section as reserved.

SECTION 2-1.

Code Section 15-11-2 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to definitions for the Juvenile Code, is amended by revising division (12)(A)(iii) as follows:

"(iii) Aggravated assault upon an individual or situation described in subsection (d),

(h), or (k), or (l) of Code Section 16-5-21 or assault with a deadly weapon or with any object, device, or instrument which, when used offensively against a person, actually does result in serious bodily injury, provided that such deadly weapon is not a firearm; and provided, further, that such injured person is not a public safety officer as defined in Code Section 16-5-19 and such acts are not prohibited under subsection (c) of Code Section 16-5-21;"

PART III107 **SECTION 3-1.**

All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
