

House Bill 663

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 40-6-189 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 classification as super speeder, fees, and funding for trauma care system, so as to provide for
3 a notice to be given to persons cited for speeding violations which could result in them
4 becoming super speeders under the law; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting
5 laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 Code Section 40-6-189 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to classification
9 as super speeder, fees, and funding for trauma care system, is amended by adding a new
10 subsection to read as follows:

11 "(f) The department shall promulgate a notice which shall be given to each person who is
12 cited for driving at a speed of 85 miles an hour or more on any road or highway or 75 miles
13 per hour or more on any two-lane road or highway, as defined in Code Section 40-6-187,
14 by the law enforcement officer issuing the citation. Such notice shall inform the person
15 being cited of the potential penalties such person could receive if such person is convicted
16 of the offenses alleged. The notice shall include the penalties provided in this Code section
17 and the points which may be assessed against such person's driver's license under Code
18 Section 40-5-57. It shall be duty of each law enforcement officer issuing a citation for
19 driving at a speed of 85 miles an hour or more on any road or highway or 75 miles per hour
20 or more on any two-lane road or highway, as defined in Code Section 40-6-187, to provide
21 such notice to the person being cited at the same time as the citation."

22 **SECTION 2.**

23 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
