## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 40-6-189 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 classification as super speeder, fees, and funding for trauma care system, so as to provide for
- 3 a notice to be given to persons cited for speeding violations which could result in them
- 4 becoming super speeders under the law; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting
- 5 laws; and for other purposes.

## 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Code Section 40-6-189 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to classification
- 9 as super speeder, fees, and funding for trauma care system, is amended by adding a new
- 10 subsection to read as follows:

- 11 "(f) The department shall promulgate a notice which shall be given to each person who is
- 12 <u>cited for driving at a speed of 85 miles an hour or more on any road or highway or 75 miles</u>
- per hour or more on any two-lane road or highway, as defined in Code Section 40-6-187,
- by the law enforcement officer issuing the citation. Such notice shall inform the person
- being cited of the potential penalties such person could receive if such person is convicted
- of the offenses alleged. The notice shall include the penalties provided in this Code section
- 18 Section 40-5-57. It shall be duty of each law enforcement officer issuing a citation for

and the points which may be assessed against such person's driver's license under Code

- driving at a speed of 85 miles an hour or more on any road or highway or 75 miles per hour
- or more on any two-lane road or highway, as defined in Code Section 40-6-187, to provide
- such notice to the person being cited at the same time as the citation."

SECTION 2.

23 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
