A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 6 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to the "Quality Basic Education Act," so as to add a program for students living in
- 3 poverty to the table of quality basic education instructional programs with weights and
- 4 student-teacher ratios; to provide for definitions; to provide for a short title; to provide for
- 5 related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 This Act shall be known and may be cited as the "Georgia Educational Opportunity Act."

- 10 Article 6 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
- 11 "Quality Basic Education Act," is amended by revising Code Section 20-2-130, relating to
- 12 short title, as follows:

- 14 (a) This article shall be known and may be cited as the 'Quality Basic Education Act.'
