A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to education, so as to
- 2 provide for the exercise of law enforcement authority by certain law enforcement officers
- 3 involved in school related functions or activities; to provide for related matters; to provide
- 4 for an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to education, is amended in
- 8 Code Section 20-2-1183, relating to written agreement for law enforcement officers in
- 9 schools, as follows:
- 10 "20-2-1183.

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- When a local school system assigns or employs law enforcement officers in schools to
- provide law enforcement services on school property, on school vehicles, at designated
- school bus stops, at school related functions or activities, or when providing protective
- public safety services while accompanying students or school personnel in transit to or
- 15 <u>from school related functions or activities</u>, the local board of education shall have a
- 16 collaborative written agreement with law enforcement officials to establish the role of law

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enforcement and school employees in school disciplinary matters and ensure coordination and cooperation among officials, agencies, and programs involved in school discipline and public protection."

20 SECTION 2.

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Said title is further amended in Code Section 20-8-5, relating to law enforcement powers of school security personnel in each public school system of the state, certification, and carrying of firearms or weapons, by revising subsection (a) as follows:

"(a) In each <u>public local</u> school system in this state, school security personnel employed by the <u>local</u> board of education of a county or an independent board of education of a municipality for the various public schools thereof who are certified pursuant to subsection (b) of this Code section and who are authorized by the <u>such local</u> board of education of that county or the independent board of education of that municipality shall have the same law enforcement powers on school property, <u>on school vehicles</u>, at <u>designated school bus stops</u>, at school related functions or activities, or when providing <u>protective public safety services while accompanying students or school personnel in transit to or from school related functions or activities, including the power of arrest, as law enforcement officers of that respective the county or municipality in which the local school system is located."</u>

35 SECTION 3.

This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law without such approval.

38 SECTION 4.

39 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
