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The Senate Committee on Veterans, Military and Homeland Security offered the following substitute to HB 68:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 1 of Title 43 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to

- 9 provisions of professions and businesses, is amended by revising Code Section 43-1-34.1,
- 10 relating to expedited license by endorsement for military spouses, as follows:

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- 12 (a) As used in this Code section, the term:
- 13 (1) 'License' shall have the same meaning as provided in Code Section 43-1-34.
- 14 (2) 'Military' shall have the same meaning as provided in Code Section 43-1-34.

- 16 (4) 'Service member' shall have the same meaning as provided in Code Section 43-1-34.

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17 (5) 'State' means a state of the United States, the District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, the

- 20 (6) 'Transitioning service member' shall have the same meaning as provided in Code
- 21 Section 43-1-34.
- 22 (b) Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, a professional licensing board or other
- board shall issue an expedited license by endorsement to any individual that:
- 24 (1) Is a spouse of a service member or transitioning service member stationed within this
- 25 state;
- 26 (2) Holds a current license to practice such occupation or profession issued by another
- state for which the training, experience, and testing are substantially similar in
- qualifications and scope to the requirements under this state to obtain a license;
- 29 (3) Is in good standing in such other state; and
- 30 (4) Passes any examination that may only be required to demonstrate knowledge of the
- laws and rules and regulations of this state specific to the practice of the profession,
- business, or trade for which such expedited license by endorsement is being sought.
- 33 (c) Notwithstanding any other provisions of law, a professional licensing board or other
- 34 board shall issue a license by endorsement for any license other than those provided to
- dentists under Chapter 11 or to physicians or osteopaths under Chapter 34 of this title to
- any individual that:
- 37 (1) Moves from another state and establishes residency in this state;
- 38 (2) Holds a current license to practice such occupation or profession issued by another
- state that was acquired prior to moving from another state and establishing residency in
- 40 this state for which the training, experience, and testing are substantially similar in
- 41 qualifications and scope to the requirements under this state to obtain a license;
- 42 (3) Is in good standing in such other state and is not the subject of an investigation being
- conducted by a professional licensing board or other board in such other state; and

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44 (4) Passes any examination that may only be required to demonstrate knowledge of the

- 45 laws and rules and regulations of this state specific to the practice of the profession,
- business, or trade for which such license by endorsement is being sought.
- 47 (c)(d) Nothing contained in this Code section shall be construed to invalidate, override, or
- 48 amend any licensing compact entered into by the State of Georgia or to permit the issuance
- 49 of a license without verification under Code Section 50-36-1."

- 51 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law

- 54 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
