A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To provide for charter review commissions for all municipal corporations located wholly or
partially in DeKalb County, Georgia; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting
laws; and for other purposes.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

There is hereby created a charter review commission for each of the following municipal 6 7 corporations located wholly or partially within DeKalb County, Georgia: the City of Atlanta, 8 the City of Avondale Estates, the City of Brookhaven, the City of Chamblee, the City of 9 Clarkston, the City of Decatur, the City of Doraville, the City of Dunwoody, the City of 10 Lithonia, the City of Pine Lake, the City of Stonecrest, the City of Stone Mountain, and the 11 City of Tucker. Each such charter review commission shall be composed of: two members 12 appointed by the DeKalb County House of Representatives legislative delegation to the Georgia General Assembly, which legislative delegation shall be composed of all 13 14 Representatives in the Georgia General Assembly whose districts are located wholly or 15 partially in DeKalb County; two members appointed by the DeKalb County Senate legislative delegation to the Georgia General Assembly, which legislative delegation shall 16 be composed of all Senators in the Georgia General Assembly whose districts are located 17 wholly or partially in DeKalb County; one member appointed by the DeKalb County 18 19 legislative delegation to the Georgia General Assembly, which legislative delegation shall be composed of all Senators and Representatives in the Georgia General Assembly whose 20 districts are located wholly or partially in DeKalb County; a former chief executive officer 21 22 of DeKalb County who receives no compensation from such county or from any municipality in the county; and a former mayor of a municipality located in DeKalb County who receives 23 24 no compensation from such county or from any municipality in the county. All members shall be appointed no later than 90 days after the effective date of this Act. Members of each 25 26 charter review commission shall select a chairperson by majority vote. Beginning on

September 1, 2019, each charter review commission shall undertake a study of the 27 28 conditions, needs, issues, and problems arising from the respective local Acts governing the 29 above-named municipalities and recommend any actions or legislation that each respective commission deems appropriate to the DeKalb County legislative delegation to the Georgia 30 General Assembly. Each charter review commission may conduct meetings at such places 31 and at such times as deemed necessary or convenient to enable it to exercise fully and 32 effectively its powers, perform its duties, and accomplish the objectives and purposes of this 33 34 Act. Each municipal governing authority of the above-named municipalities shall provide staff support and research necessary for its respective charter review commission to complete 35 Each charter review commission shall make a report of its findings and 36 its task. recommendations with suggestions for proposed legislation no later than January 15, 2020. 37
