## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 2 of Chapter 7 of Title 48 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to imposition, rate, computation, and exemptions from state income taxes, so as to
- 3 provide for the reporting of statistics related to the classification of counties into tiers for
- 4 economic development purposes; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws;
- 5 and for other purposes.

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## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.** Article 2 of Chapter 7 of Title 48 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to 8 9 imposition, rate, computation, and exemptions from state income taxes, is amended by 10 revising subsection (k) of Code Section 48-7-40, relating to designation of counties as less 11 developed areas and tax credits for certain business enterprises, as follows: 12 "(k)(1) Beginning on or before September 1, 2019, and annually for five years thereafter, 13 the commissioner shall issue a report to the Governor, President of the Senate, and 14 Speaker of the House of Representatives concerning the tax credit created by this Code 15 section. Such report shall include a list of all counties and their tier classifications 16 established pursuant to this Code section and the following statistics presented on a 17 state-wide, county-tier, and county-by-county basis for the preceding taxable year: (A) The total number of employers that claimed a credit provided by this Code section; 18 19 (B) The number and total value of all credits earned and all credits applied during such 20 tax year pursuant to this Code section; and 21 (C) An estimate of the number of jobs and overall economic impact produced by this 22 Code section. 23 (B)(2) The commissioner may require such reports, promulgate such regulations, and 24 gather such relevant data necessary and advisable for the evaluation of the job tax credits 25 established by shall promulgate such rules and regulations necessary to implement and 26 administer the provisions of this Code section."

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## 27 **SECTION 2.**

All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
