A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 40-5-25 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to  
2 drivers' license applications, fees, waiver of fees, and provisions for voluntary participation  
3 in various related programs, so as to provide that a military identification card may serve as  
4 satisfactory documentation of an individual's social security number; to provide for related  
5 matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 Code Section 40-5-25 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to drivers' license  
9 applications, fees, waiver of fees, and provisions for voluntary participation in various related  
10 programs, is amended by revising subsection (c) as follows:

11 "(c) Every such application shall state the full legal name, date of birth, sex, and residence  
12 address of the applicant; shall briefly describe the applicant; shall state whether the  
13 applicant has theretofore been licensed as a driver and, if so, when and by what state or  
14 country, and whether any such license has ever been suspended, revoked, or refused, and,  
15 if so, the date of and reason for such suspension, revocation, or refusal; and shall state such  
16 other information as the commissioner may require to determine the applicant's identity,  
17 competence, and eligibility. The application shall include any other information as  
18 required by paragraph (1) of subsection (a.1) of Code Section 19-11-9.1. The department  
19 shall not issue a license until a complete examination of the applicant's record has been  
20 completed. The commissioner may issue such rules and regulations as shall be necessary  
21 for the orderly processing of license applications. A military identification card shall serve  
22 as satisfactory documentation of an individual's social security number."

23 **SECTION 2.**

24 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
