## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 40-5-25 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 drivers' license applications, fees, waiver of fees, and provisions for voluntary participation
- 3 in various related programs, so as to provide that a military identification card may serve as
- 4 satisfactory documentation of an individual's social security number; to provide for related
- 5 matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.** 

- 8 Code Section 40-5-25 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to drivers' license
- 9 applications, fees, waiver of fees, and provisions for voluntary participation in various related
- 10 programs, is amended by revising subsection (c) as follows:
- 11 "(c) Every such application shall state the full legal name, date of birth, sex, and residence
- 12 address of the applicant; shall briefly describe the applicant; shall state whether the
- applicant has theretofore been licensed as a driver and, if so, when and by what state or 13
- 14 country, and whether any such license has ever been suspended, revoked, or refused, and,
- 15 if so, the date of and reason for such suspension, revocation, or refusal; and shall state such
- 16 other information as the commissioner may require to determine the applicant's identity,
- 17 competence, and eligibility. The application shall include any other information as
- required by paragraph (1) of subsection (a.1) of Code Section 19-11-9.1. The department shall not issue a license until a complete examination of the applicant's record has been 19
- 20 completed. The commissioner may issue such rules and regulations as shall be necessary
- 21 for the orderly processing of license applications. A military identification card shall serve
- 22 as satisfactory documentation of an individual's social security number."
