A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 20E of Title 33 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, the "Surprise
- 2 Billing Consumer Protection Act," so as to require a nonparticipating provider, prior to
- 3 performing any healthcare services, to notify a covered person if such services will require
- 4 \$100.00 or more in out-of-pocket costs; to provide for related matters; to provide for an
- 5 effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Chapter 20E of Title 33 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, the "Surprise Billing
- 9 Consumer Protection Act," is amended in Code Section 33-20E-4, relating to payment for
- 10 emergency medical services, by adding a new subsection to read as follows:
- 11 "(g) Prior to the provision of any emergency medical services by a nonparticipating
- provider, such provider shall notify a covered person if such services will require \$100.00
- or more in out-of-pocket costs."

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- 15 Said chapter is further amended in Code Section 33-20E-5, relating to payment for
- 16 nonemergency medical services, by adding a new subsection to read as follows:
- 17 "(f) Prior to the provision of any nonemergency medical services by a nonparticipating
- provider, such provider shall notify a covered person if such services will require \$100.00
- or more in out-of-pocket costs."
- SECTION 3.
- 21 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2023.
- SECTION 4.
- 23 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
