6	Code Section 45-20-110, relating to definitions for drug testing for state employment, is
7	amended by revising paragraph (3) as follows:
8	"(3) 'Illegal drug' means marijuana/cannabinoids (THC), cocaine,
9	amphetamines/methamphetamines, opiates opioids, or phencyclidine (PCP). The Such
10	term 'illegal drug' shall not include any drug when used pursuant to a valid prescription
11	or when used as otherwise authorized by state or federal law."
