To amend an Act amending the several Acts relating to and incorporating the Mayor and
Aldermen of the City of Savannah, approved March 17, 1978 (Ga. L. 1978, p. 3998), as
amended, particularly by an Act approved March 20, 1990 (Ga. L. 1990, p. 3995), so as to
implement a limitation on the number of terms the aldermen may serve; to repeal conflicting
laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

8 An Act amending the several Acts relating to and incorporating the Mayor and Aldermen of 9 the City of Savannah, approved March 17, 1978 (Ga. L. 1978, p. 3998), as amended, 10 particularly by an Act approved March 20, 1990 (Ga. L. 1990, p. 3995), is amended by 11 revising subsection (d) of quoted Section 2 of Section 1 of said Act as follows:

12 "(d) The mayor and aldermen shall be elected at an election held on the Tuesday following 13 the first Monday of November immediately preceding the expiration of their terms of office 14 and shall take office on the first day of January immediately following their election for 15 terms of four years and until their successors are duly elected and qualified, provided that 16 any mayor who has been elected for two consecutive four-year terms of office shall not be eligible to be elected for the succeeding term. Any alderman who has been elected for three consecutive four-year terms of office in the same district or the same at-large post shall not be eligible to be elected for the succeeding term in the same district or the same at-large post; provided, however, that any terms to which an alderman was elected prior to July 1, 2023, shall not count toward the limit provided for in this subsection."
