## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 33-24-59.23 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 carrier issuing health benefit plans to pay insurance agent's commissions and regulation
- 3 authority, so as to provide that carriers issuing a health benefit plan in this state through an
- 4 agent shall file proposed commission rates with the department; to provide that carriers that
- 5 do not pay commission during special enrollments shall upon policy renewals pay such
- 6 commission along with renewal commission; to provide for related matters; to provide for
- 7 an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

9 **SECTION 1.** 

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- 10 Code Section 33-24-59.23 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to carrier
- issuing health benefit plans to pay insurance agent's commissions and regulation authority,
- is amended by revising subsection (b) as follows:
- 13 "(b) Any carrier that issues a health benefit plan in this state through an agent shall pay a
- commission to such agent,. Such carrier shall file with the department its proposed
- commission rates relevant to all such agents. The commission paid to such agents shall
- by the Commissioner. Such commission shall be structured to compensate the agent for

be consistent with the amount proposed in the rates filed with the department, as required

- the first term and for each renewal term thereafter, so long as such agent reviews coverage
- and provides ongoing customer service for such plan; provided, however, that no such <u>first</u>
- 20 <u>term</u> compensation <u>to such agent</u> shall be required for any individual health benefit plan
- sold during a special enrollment period. <u>Notwithstanding the above, any carrier that does</u>
- 22 not provide such first term commission during a special enrollment period shall, upon
- 23 policy renewal, provide the agent with the renewal commission and any first term
- 24 <u>commission that was not paid because such policy was sold during a special enrollment</u>
- 25 <u>period.</u> Nothing in this Code section is intended or shall be construed to require a carrier
- to pay a commission to an agent who is employed by such carrier."

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**SECTION 2.** 

28 This Act shall become effective on January 1, 2021.

SECTION 3.

30 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
