A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 40-8-11 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 operational rules for autonomous vehicles, so as to provide for the applicability of certain
- 3 consumer protection laws to autonomous vehicles; to provide for related matters; to repeal
- 4 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Code Section 40-8-11 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to operational
- 8 rules for autonomous vehicles, is amended by adding a new subsection to read as follows:
- 9 "(d) No provision of this Code section shall be construed to limit the applicability of state
- 10 consumer protection laws, including Part 2 of Article 15 of Chapter 1 of Title 10, the 'Fair
- Business Practices Act of 1975,' Article 22 of Chapter 1 of Title 10, the 'Georgia Motor
- 12 <u>Vehicle Franchise Practices Act,' and Article 28 of Chapter 1 of Title 10, the 'Georgia</u>
- 13 <u>Lemon Law.'</u>"
- SECTION 2.
- 15 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
