A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 20-2-161.3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to  
2 the "Move on When Ready Act" and dual credit courses, so as to revise the definition of  
3 eligible postsecondary institution; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws;  
4 and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 style="text-align:center">**SECTION 1.**

7 Code Section 20-2-161.3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the "Move  
8 on When Ready Act" and dual credit courses, is amended by revising paragraph (6) of  
9 subsection (b) as follows:

10 "(6) 'Eligible postsecondary institution' or 'postsecondary institution' means any eligible  
11 postsecondary institution as defined in paragraph (7) of Code Section 20-3-519 and any  
12 nonprofit, baccalaureate degree granting postsecondary institution which has been in  
13 existence ten or more years with a physical location in this state and which holds  
14 institutional accreditation by a national or regional accrediting agency that is recognized  
15 by either the Council for Higher Education Accreditation or the United States Department  
16 of Education."

18 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
