A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 1 of Title 28 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 general provisions regarding the General Assembly, so as to provide that members of the
- 3 General Assembly who are in office and former members of the General Assembly who have
- 4 been out of office for less than one year shall be prohibited from employment in state
- 5 government while in office and for a period of one year after leaving such office; to provide
- 6 for exceptions; to provide for related matters; to provide an effective date; to repeal
- 7 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

9 **SECTION 1.**

- 10 Chapter 1 of Title 28 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general
- provisions regarding the General Assembly, is amended by adding a new Code section to
- 12 read as follows:
- 13 "<u>28-1-18.</u>
- 14 (a) On and after the effective date of this Code section, members of the General Assembly
- who are in office and former members of the General Assembly who have been out of
- office as a member of the General Assembly for less than one year shall be prohibited from
- 17 <u>employment in state government while in office and for a period of one year after leaving</u>
- 18 <u>such office.</u>
- 19 (b) The prohibition contained in subsection (a) of this Code section shall not apply to
- 20 persons who are elected or appointed to elective offices within state government."
- 21 SECTION 2.
- 22 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 23 without such approval.
