# A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Chapter 8 of Title 48 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to sales
and use taxes, so as to create an exemption from state sales and use tax for certain veterinary
diagnostic and disease monitoring services; to provide for related matters; to repeal
conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

# BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

#### 6 **SECTION 1.** 7 Chapter 8 of Title 48 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to sales and use 8 taxes, is amended in Code Section 48-8-3, relating to exemptions from state sales and use 9 taxes, by deleting "or" at the end of subparagraph (E) of paragraph (99), by replacing the 10 period with "; or" at the end of subparagraph (C) of paragraph (100), and by adding a new 11 paragraph to read as follows: 12 "(101) Sales to or by any nonprofit organization which has as its primary purpose providing veterinary diagnostic and disease monitoring services if such organization 13 14 qualifies as a tax-exempt organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code." 15
