A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 2 of Chapter 13 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to arrests, trials, and appeals relating to the prosecution of traffic offenses, so as to
- 3 provide for the concurrent jurisdiction of state courts and probate courts over misdemeanor
- 4 traffic offenses; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
- 5 purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Article 2 of Chapter 13 of Title 40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 9 arrests, trials, and appeals relating to the prosecution of traffic offenses, is amended by
- 10 revising Code Section 40-13-29, relating to exclusive jurisdiction, as follows:
- 11 "40-13-29.
- In all counties except those having <u>a city</u>, <u>or county</u>, <u>or state courts</u>, <u>court</u>, the judge of the
- probate court shall have exclusive jurisdiction of all traffic misdemeanor cases originating
- in the county outside of municipal corporations, and the. If a state court is created or exists
- in a county, the judge of the probate court shall have concurrent jurisdiction over all traffic
- 16 <u>misdemeanor cases with such state court.</u> The judge of the municipal court in each
- municipal corporation shall have exclusive jurisdiction of traffic misdemeanor cases
- originating inside the corporate limits of municipalities."

20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
