A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 34-2-10, relating to an employer's duty with respect to provision of
- 2 safe employment generally, so as to specify actions that an employer must take to provide
- 3 a safe place of employment; to provide for related matters; to provide for an effective date;
- 4 to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Code Section 34-2-10, relating to an employer's duty with respect to provision of safe
- 8 employment generally, is amended by adding a new subsection to read as follows:
- 9 "(c) No employer shall require, permit, or suffer any employee to enter into any
- 10 <u>employment or place of employment that is not reasonably safe for the employee or for</u>
- 11 <u>which the employer does not:</u>
- 12 (1) Furnish and use safety devices and safeguards;
- 13 (2) Adopt and use methods or processes reasonably adequate to render such employment
- or place of employment safe; or
- 15 (3) Take every action reasonably necessary to protect the life, health, safety, and welfare
- of such employee."

17 SECTION 2.

- 18 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
- 19 without such approval.

20 **SECTION 3.**

21 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
