

House Bill 758

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Article 4 of Chapter 18 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
2 relating to inspection of public records, so as to make the Open Records Act and provisions
3 for the inspection of public records applicable to the General Assembly, including its
4 committees, commissions, and offices; to revise a definition; to provide for related matters;
5 to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 Article 4 of Chapter 18 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
9 inspection of public records, is amended by revising subsection (b) of Code
10 Section 50-18-70, relating to legislative intent and definitions, as follows:

11 "(b) As used in this article, the term:

12 (1) 'Agency' shall have the same meaning as in Code Section 50-14-1 and shall
13 additionally include any:

14 (A) The General Assembly, including its committees, commissions, and offices; and

15 (B) Any association, corporation, or other similar organization that has a membership
16 or ownership body composed primarily of counties, municipal corporations, or school

17 districts of this state, their officers, or any combination thereof and derives more
18 than 33 1/3 percent of its general operating budget from payments from such political
19 subdivisions.

20 (2) 'Public record' means all documents, papers, letters, maps, books, tapes, photographs,
21 computer based or generated information, data, data fields, or similar material prepared
22 and maintained or received by an agency or by a private person or entity in the
23 performance of a service or function for or on behalf of an agency or when such
24 documents have been transferred to a private person or entity by an agency for storage
25 or future governmental use."

26 **SECTION 2.**

27 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
