## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 3 of Chapter 19 of Title 15 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to the regulation of the practice of law, so as to provide that certain activities by
- 3 financial institutions shall not constitute the unauthorized practice of law; to provide for
- 4 related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Article 3 of Chapter 19 of Title 15 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
- 8 regulation of the practice of law, is amended by revising Code Section 15-19-52, relating to
- 9 lawful acts by certain parties that shall not constitute the unauthorized practice of law, as
- 10 follows:

- 11 "15-19-52.
- Nothing contained in this article shall prevent any corporation, voluntary association, or
- individual from doing any act or acts set out in Code Section 15-19-50 to which the persons
- are a party; but, in preparing and filing affidavits in attachments and prosecuting such
- proceedings, it shall be unlawful for the plaintiffs to act through any agent or employee
- who is not a duly licensed attorney at law. Moreover, no bank financial institution, as
- defined by Code Section 7-1-4, whose deposits are federally insured shall be prohibited
- from giving any advice to its customers in matters incidental to banks or banking providing
- 19 <u>financial services</u>; nor shall any person, firm, or corporation be prohibited from drawing
- any legal instrument for another person, firm, or corporation, provided it is done without
- fee and solely at the solicitation and the request and under the direction of the person, firm,

or corporation desiring to execute the instrument. Furthermore, a title insurance company

- may prepare such papers as it thinks proper or necessary in connection with a title which
- 24 it proposes to insure, in order, in its opinion, for it to be willing to insure the title, where
- 25 no charge is made by it for the papers."
