

The House Committee on Motor Vehicles offers the following substitute to HB 766:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 40-2-86 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 special license plates promoting and supporting certain beneficial projects, agencies, funds,
3 or nonprofit corporations, so as to establish a specialty license plate to benefit Alabama
4 A&M University; to provide for related matters; to provide for an effective date; to provide
5 for compliance with constitutional requirements; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
6 purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 **SECTION 1.**

9 Code Section 40-2-86 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to special license
10 plates promoting and supporting certain beneficial projects, agencies, funds, or nonprofit
11 corporations, is amended by adding a new paragraph to subsection (l) to read as follows:

12 "(57) A special license plate honoring Alabama A&M University. The funds raised by
13 the sale of this special license plate shall be disbursed to the Alabama A&M University
14 Alumni Association, Inc., and used to provide scholarships and financial assistance to
15 Georgia residents attending the university. Such special license plate shall include the
16 phrase 'Go Bulldogs' in lieu of the county of issuance."

17 **SECTION 2.**

18 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2019.

19 **SECTION 3.**

20 In accordance with the requirements of Article III, Section IX, Paragraph VI(n) of the
21 Constitution of the State of Georgia, this Act shall not become law unless it receives the
22 requisite two-thirds' majority vote in both the Senate and the House of Representatives.

SECTION 4.

24 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
