A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 10 of Title 31 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to vital
- 2 records, so as to provide for the Department of Public Health to collect certain information
- 3 regarding suicides in this state; to provide for annual reports; to amend Article 1 of Chapter
- 4 4 of Title 38 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the Department of
- 5 Veterans Service, so as to provide for the creation of the Commission on Veteran Suicide
- 6 Prevention; to provide for the composition and duties of such commission; to provide for
- 7 related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

9 **SECTION 1.**

- 10 Chapter 10 of Title 31 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to vital records,
- 11 is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 12 <u>"31-10-34.</u>
- 13 (a) Beginning January 1, 2021, in addition to other information currently being collected,
- 14 the department shall provide for the collection of the following information regarding each
- person who dies in this state who served in the armed forces of the United States:
- 16 (1) Whether the decedent served in the regular, reserve, or National Guard component
- of the United States armed forces or the United States Coast Guard; the length and
- location of such service; and the branch of the armed forces in which the decedent served;
- 19 (2) The location of the decedent's residence and death;
- 20 (3) The decedent's occupation, industry, or business;
- 21 (4) The cause of the decedent's death, and if by suicide, the method used; and
- 22 (5) The age, sex, and race or ethnicity of the decedent.
- 23 (b) The department shall annually create a report on veteran suicide in this state and shall
- 24 <u>include in such report the information obtained pursuant to this Code section. Such report</u>
- 25 <u>shall be provided to the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the Lieutenant Governor,</u>
- and the Commission on Veteran Suicide Prevention."

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SECTION 2.

- 28 Article 1 of Chapter 4 of Title 38 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
- 29 Department of Veterans Service, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as
- 30 follows:
- 31 "<u>38-4-15.</u>
- 32 (a) There is created within the Department of Veterans Service the Commission on
- 33 <u>Veteran Suicide Prevention.</u>
- 34 (b) The commission shall be composed of:
- 35 (1) The commissioner of veterans service who shall serve as chairperson;
- 36 (2) Two members who shall be appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the Governor;
- 37 (3) One member who shall be appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the Speaker of
- 38 <u>the House of Representatives; and</u>
- 39 (4) One member who shall be appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the Lieutenant
- 40 Governor.
- 41 (c) The commission shall review each report prepared by the Department of Public Health
- 42 <u>pursuant to Code Section 31-10-34 and shall make such recommendations to the Governor</u>
- 43 and the General Assembly for preventing veteran suicides as it deems appropriate based
- 44 upon the data contained in such reports.
- 45 (d) The Department of Veterans Service shall provide such administrative support as
- 46 <u>necessary for the commission to perform its duties."</u>

47 SECTION 3.

48 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
