A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend an Act to provide for the election of the members of the Paulding County Board
- of Education, approved March 21, 1968 (Ga. L. 1968, p. 2381), as amended, particularly by
- 3 an Act approved April 25, 2002 (Ga. L. 2002, p. 4151), so as to revise provisions related to
- 4 filling vacancies on the board; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and
- 5 for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 An Act to provide for the election of the members of the Paulding County Board of
- 9 Education, approved March 21, 1968 (Ga. L. 1968, p. 2381), as amended, particularly by an
- 10 Act approved April 25, 2002 (Ga. L. 2002, p. 4151), is amended by revising Section 3 as
- 11 follows:
- 12 "SECTION 3.
- 13 (a) In the event a vacancy occurs on the board for any reason other than expiration of term
- of office:

(1) If the vacancy occurs more than 90 days prior to the date of a general election preceding the general election at which a successor will be elected to a new full term of office, then such vacancy shall be filled for the unexpired term of office at a special election to be held on the same date as said general election preceding the general election at which a successor will be elected to a new full term of office; and in this case the remaining members of the board of education shall, by majority vote, select a qualified person to fill the vacancy until the person elected at such special election takes office: and

- (2) If the vacancy does not occur more than 90 days prior to the date of a general election preceding the general election at which a successor will be elected to a new full term of office, then the remaining members of the local board of education shall, by majority vote, select a qualified person to serve for the remainder of the unexpired term.
- 27 (b) In the event a member moves his or her residence from the education district he or she 28 represents, a vacancy shall exist.
- 29 (c) At its first meeting each year, the members of the board shall elect one of their number to serve as chairperson for that year and until the election of a chairperson in the subsequent year. A member shall be eligible to succeed himself or herself as a member of 32 the board and also as chairperson of the board."
