A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To create a board of elections and registration for Chatham County; to provide for its powers 2 and duties; to provide for definitions; to provide for the composition of the board and the 3 election, selection, and appointment of members and an elections supervisor; to provide for 4 the qualifications, terms, and removal of members; to provide for vacancies; to provide for 5 oaths and privileges; to provide for the conduct of primaries and elections; to provide for meetings; to authorize the conduct of municipal elections; to allow for joint primaries; to 6 7 authorize expenditure of public funds; to provide compensation for board members and staff; 8 to provide for offices, supplies, and other materials; to provide for the transfer of powers, 9 duties, facilities, and personal property; to provide for related matters; to provide effective 10 dates; to repeal a specific Act; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

13 Pursuant to subsection (b) of Code Section 21-2-40 of the Official Code of Georgia

14 Annotated, there is created the Board of Elections and Registration of Chatham County. The

15 Board of Elections and Registration of Chatham County shall have the powers, duties, and

16 responsibilities of the superintendent of elections of Chatham County under Chapter 2 of

17 Title 21 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, the "Georgia Election Code," as the same

- 18 now exists or may hereafter be amended, which powers, duties, and responsibilities are
- 19 currently being exercised by the Board of Elections of Chatham County, and the powers,
- 20 duties, and responsibilities of the Board of Registrars of Chatham County under Chapter 2
- 21 of Title 21 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, the "Georgia Election Code," as the
- same now exists or may hereafter be amended.

23 SECTION 2.

- 24 As used in this Act, the term:
- 25 (1) "Board" means the Chatham County Board of Elections and Registration.
- 26 (2) "Commissioners" means the Board of Commissioners of Chatham County.
- 27 (3) "County" means Chatham County.
- 28 (4) "Election," "elector," "primary," and "public office" shall have the same meanings
- as ascribed to those terms by Code Section 21-2-2 of the Official Code of Georgia
- Annotated, unless otherwise clearly apparent from the text of this Act.

31 SECTION 3.

- 32 (a) The board shall be composed of five members elected or appointed to four-year terms 33 of office, each of whom shall be an elector and resident of Chatham County.
- 34 (b)(1) At each primary held for candidates for the office of Governor, one member shall
- be elected by the political party whose candidate for the office of Governor at the last
- 36 election for such office received the highest number of votes cast for such office within
- 37 the county; and
- 38 (2) At each primary held for candidates for the office of Governor, one member shall be
- 39 elected by the political party whose candidate for the office of Governor at the last
- 40 election for such office received the second highest number of votes cast for such office
- 41 within the county.

42 (c) Three members shall be appointed by the chief judge of the Eastern Judicial Circuit,

43 regardless of partisan affiliation or status.

44 SECTION 4.

No person who holds elective public office shall be eligible to serve as a member of the board during the term of such elective public office, and the position of membership of any member shall be deemed vacant upon such member's qualifying as a candidate for an elective public office. Each member of the board shall be eligible to serve successive terms, shall have the right to resign at any time by giving written notice of such resignation to the clerk of the Superior Court of Chatham County, and shall be subject to removal at any time, for cause, after notice and hearing in the same manner as provided by general law for the removal of registrars.

53 SECTION 5.

(a) The appointment of each appointed member of the board shall be evidenced by the chief judge of the Eastern Judicial Circuit filing an order with the clerk of the Superior Court of Chatham County no later than 30 days preceding the date on which such member is to take office, stating the name and residence address of the person appointed and certifying that such member has been duly appointed as provided in this Act. The clerk of the Superior Court of Chatham County shall be notified of any interim appointments and shall record and certify such appointments in the same manner as the regular appointment of members. The clerk of the Superior Court of Chatham County shall record each certification on the minutes of that superior court and shall certify the name of each member to the Secretary of State and provide for the issuance of appropriate commissions to the members as provided by law for county registrars.

(b) The election of each elected member of the board shall be evidenced by the certification of the results of such election in a manner provided by Chapter 2 of Title 21

of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, the "Georgia Election Code." Each elected member of the board shall be subject to removal from office for misfeasance or malfeasance in office on the grounds of and in the manner prescribed for the removal of clerks of the superior court as provided in Code Section 15-6-82 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated.

72 SECTION 6.

In the event a vacancy occurs on the board by removal, death, resignation, or otherwise, the chief judge of the Eastern Judicial Circuit shall appoint a qualified person to serve for the remainder of the unexpired term. Such appointments shall be certified by such chief judge in the same manner as the regular appointments of members.

77 SECTION 7.

Before entering upon his or her duties, a member of the board shall take substantially the same oath as required by law for registrars and shall have the same privileges from arrest.

SECTION 8.

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The board shall be empowered with all the powers and duties relating to the conduct of primaries and elections as election superintendent pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 2 of Title 21 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, the "Georgia Election Code." The board shall be empowered with all the powers and duties relating to the registration of voters and absentee balloting procedures as boards of registrars pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 2 of Title 21 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, the "Georgia Election Code." This Act is intended to implement the provisions of subsection (b) of Code Section 21-2-40 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated and shall be construed liberally so as to effectuate that purpose. The board shall be authorized and empowered to organize itself, determine its procedural rules and regulations, adopt bylaws, specify the functions and duties of its

employees, and otherwise take such action as is appropriate to the management of its affairs; provided, however, that no such action shall conflict with state law. Action and decision by the board shall be by a majority of the members of the board.

94 SECTION 9.

The board shall fix and establish, by appropriate resolution entered on its minutes, directives governing the execution of matters within its jurisdiction. The board shall hold meetings in its offices. Any specially called meetings held pursuant to bylaws adopted by the board shall be held only after notification of the time and place of the holding of such meeting has been communicated in writing to the elections supervisor in order to provide public notice of the meetings as required by law. All meetings of whatever kind of the board shall be conducted pursuant to Chapter 14 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to open meetings. The board shall maintain a written record of policy decisions that shall be amended to include additions or deletions. Such written records shall be subject to Article 4 of Chapter 18 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to inspection of public records.

SECTION 10.

The board shall elect from its membership a person to serve as chairperson and may elect from its membership persons to serve as vice chairperson and secretary. The chairperson of the board shall chair all meetings of the board, serve as spokesperson for the board, and shall generally supervise, direct, and control the administration of the affairs of the board pursuant to law and duly adopted resolutions of the board.

SECTION 11.

The board shall have the authority to conduct municipal elections and primaries for any municipality located within the county if such municipality has entered into a contract for that purpose with the commissioners and in conformance with Code Section 21-2-45 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated.

SECTION 12.

Nothing in this Act shall be construed to require or prohibit joint primaries or to require or prohibit the commissioners or any other public agency to bear any expense of conducting primaries not otherwise required by law.

SECTION 13.

The board shall be authorized to expend public funds for the purpose of preparing and distributing material solely to inform and instruct electors of the county adequately with regard to elections. No material distributed by the board shall contain or express, in any manner or form, any commentary or expression of opinion or request for support with respect to any political issue or matter of political concern.

SECTION 14.

Compensation for the members of the board, the elections supervisor, clerical assistants, and other employees shall be fixed by the commissioners. In addition thereto, the members of the board shall be reimbursed for their actual and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duties. All amounts payable under this section shall be paid from county funds.

133	SECTION 15.
134	The commissioners shall provide the board with such proper and suitable offices, equipment,
135	materials, and supplies and with such clerical assistance and other employees as the
136	commissioners deem appropriate.
137	SECTION 16.
138	Upon the effective date of this Act, the Board of Elections of Chatham County and the Board
139	of Registrars of Chatham County shall be relieved of all powers and duties and shall be
140	transferred to the board by this Act. Such board of elections and board of registrars shall
141	deliver to the board all facilities and personal property, including but not limited to
142	equipment, supplies, materials, books, papers, and records pertaining to such powers and
143	duties.
144	SECTION 17.
145	This Act shall become effective on January 1, 2023; provided, however, that for purposes of
146	making the initial appointment, election, and certification of the board established herein, this
147	Act shall become effective on July 1, 2021.
148	SECTION 18.
149	An Act creating the Board of Elections of Chatham County, approved March 29, 1984
150	(Ga. L. 1984, p. 5197), and all amendatory Acts are hereby repealed in their entirety.
151	SECTION 19.
152	All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
