A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 8 of Chapter 4 of Title 3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to tastings, so as to authorize limited retail sales of distilled spirits manufactured by
- 3 a craft distiller in a designated area on the premises of such distiller; to define certain terms;
- 4 to provide for the issuance of licenses for such retail sales; to require that the craft distiller
- 5 purchase the distilled spirits to be sold at retail from a licensed wholesaler; to specify the
- 6 price and quantity of distilled spirits that may be sold at retail by a craft distiller; to provide
- 7 for the conditions under which such retail sales may be conducted; to provide for the
- 8 collection of sales tax; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
- 9 purposes.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

- 12 Article 8 of Chapter 4 of Title 3 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 13 tastings, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 14 <u>"3-4-181.</u>
- 15 (a) As used in this Code section, the term:
- 16 (1) 'Craft distiller' means a manufacturer of distilled spirits licensed pursuant to Code
- Section 3-4-24 or 3-4-24.1 that produces on its licensed premises not more than 50,000
- gallons of distilled spirits in a calendar year.
- 19 (2) 'Licensed premises' means a location in this state where the craft distiller is licensed
- for the manufacturing, distilling, rectifying, or blending of distilled spirits.
- 21 (3) 'Retail sales' means sales of distilled spirits in unbroken packages at retail only to
- 22 <u>consumers and not for resale.</u>
- 23 (b) The commissioner shall, upon proper application therefor, issue a retail dealer's license
- 24 <u>to a craft distiller authorizing such craft distiller to offer retail sales of distilled spirits on</u>
- 25 <u>its licensed premises in a designated retail sales area that may be the same area as the</u>
- 26 <u>designated tasting area for free tastings conducted pursuant to Code Section 3-4-180. Any</u>

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| 27 | <u>craft distiller licensed as a retail dealer shall only sell distilled spirits that are manufactured</u> |
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| 28 | by such craft distiller on the licensed premises where the retail sales are being conducted |
| 29 | and then subsequently purchased by the craft distiller from a licensed wholesaler pursuant |
| 30 | to Code Section 3-4-111. A craft distiller licensed as a retail dealer shall sell no more than |
| 31 | 1.75 liters of distilled spirits to the same consumer per calendar day and shall sell such |
| 32 | distilled spirits at a price equal to or greater than the wholesale price paid by the craft |
| 33 | distiller to the licensed wholesaler for such product plus 20 percent. |
| 34 | (c) Any craft distiller conducting retail sales on its licensed premises pursuant to this Code |
| 35 | section shall pay applicable state and local sales tax on all retail sales. The craft distiller |
| 36 | shall maintain such sales tax reports, documentation, and other information as may be |
| 37 | required by the commissioner to ensure collection of all applicable taxes." |

SECTION 2.

39 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
