## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 10 of Chapter 21 of Title 15 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to the Georgia Driver's Education Commission, so as to transfer such commission
- 3 from the Department of Driver Services to the Governor's Office of Highway Safety; to
- 4 extend the sunset applicable to penalties for violations of traffic laws or ordinances; to
- 5 provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 SECTION 1.

- 8 Article 10 of Chapter 21 of Title 15 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 9 the Georgia Driver's Education Commission, is amended by revising Code Section
- 10 15-21-172, relating to the establishment of such commission, as follows:
- 11 "15-21-172.
- 12 There is established the Georgia Driver's Education Commission, which is assigned to the
- 13 Department of Driver Services Governor's Office of Highway Safety for administrative
- purposes only, as prescribed in Code Section 50-4-3."
- 15 SECTION 2.
- 16 Said article is further amended in Code Section 15-21-179, relating to additional penalty for
- 17 violation of traffic laws or ordinances, by revising subsection (c) as follows:
- 18 "(c) This Code section shall be repealed in its entirety on June 30, 2016 June 30, 2019,
- unless extended by an Act of the General Assembly."
- SECTION 3.
- 21 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
