A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Part 1 of Article 22 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia  
2 Annotated, relating to powers of state and local school officials with respect to school buses,  
3 so as to authorize local boards of education to place advertisements on school buses; to  
4 provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 style="text-align:center">**SECTION 1.**

7 Part 1 of Article 22 of Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,  
8 relating to powers of state and local school officials with respect to school buses, is amended  
9 by adding a new Code section to read as follows:

10 "20-2-1076.

11 A local board of education may authorize the placement, erection, and maintenance of  
12 commercial advertisements on school buses owned or operated by that local board. No  
13 advertisements shall interfere in the safe operation of a school bus. The local board may  
14 establish any terms and conditions for the authorization of advertisements."

16 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
