## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1	To amend Code Section 10-1-912 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2	notification required upon breach of security regarding personal information, so as to provide
3	that information brokers and data collectors shall provide notice when personal information
4	maintained on individuals by such information broker or data collector is released to
5	unauthorized persons, whether such release is intentional, inadvertent, or accidental; to
6	provide for related matters; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for
7	other purposes.

8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:
9	SECTION 1.
10	Code Section 10-1-912 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to notification
11	required upon breach of security regarding personal information, is amended by adding a
12	new subsection to read as follows:
13	"(e) In addition to the other requirements of this Code section, an information broker or
14	data collector shall also provide the notice required by this Code section in the same
15	manner as for a breach in the security of the system when personal information maintained
16	on individuals by such information broker or data collector is released to unauthorized
17	persons, whether such release is intentional, inadvertent, or accidental."
18	SECTION 2.
19	This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
20	without such approval.
21	SECTION 3.

22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
