A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 1 of Chapter 8 of Title 48 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to sales and use tax, so as to provide for a change in a definition; to provide for
- 3 related matters; to provide for an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
- 4 purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Article 1 of Chapter 8 of Title 48 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to sales
- 8 and use tax, is amended by revising paragraph (4) of subsection (a) of Code Section 48-8-3.3,
- 9 relating to the sales and use tax exemption for agricultural machinery and equipment, as
- 10 follows:

- 11 "(4) 'Energy used in agriculture' means fuels used for agricultural purposes, other than
- fuels subject to prepaid state tax as defined in Code Section 48-8-2. The term includes,
- but is not limited to, off-road diesel, propane, butane, electricity, natural gas, wood, wood
- products, or wood by-products; liquefied petroleum gas or other fuel used in structures
- in which broilers, pullets, or other poultry are raised, in which swine are raised, in which
- dairy animals are raised or milked or where dairy products are stored on a farm, in which

agricultural products are stored, and in which plants, seedlings, nursery stock, or floral

- products are raised primarily for the purposes of making sales of such plants, seedlings,
- nursery stock, or floral products for resale; electricity or other fuel for the operation of
- an irrigation system which is used on a farm exclusively for the irrigation of agricultural
- products; and electricity or other fuel used in the drying, cooking, or further processing
- of raw agricultural products, including, but not limited to, food processing of raw
- agricultural products."
