A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 7 of Chapter 4 of Title 49 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to medical assistance generally, so as to provide for the authorization of
- 3 appropriations for the purposes of obtaining federal financial participation for medical
- 4 assistance payments to providers of Medicaid expansion under the federal Patient Protection
- 5 and Affordable Care Act and Health Care and Education Reconciliation Act of 2010; to
- 6 provide for a maximum percent of the federal poverty level; to provide for a short title; to
- 7 provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

9 SECTION 1.

10 This Act shall be known and may be cited as the "Expand Medicaid Now Act."

11 SECTION 2.

- 12 Article 7 of Chapter 4 of Title 49 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- medical assistance generally, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 14 "<u>49-4-158.</u>
- 15 (a) Appropriations shall be authorized for the purposes of obtaining federal financial
- participation for medical assistance payments to providers on behalf of Medicaid recipients
- pursuant to this article and funding the state's portion of the cost to expand the Medicaid
- 18 program under the federal Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (Public
- 19 <u>Law 111-148</u>), as amended by the federal Health Care and Education Reconciliation Act
- 20 <u>of 2010 (Public Law 111-152), and any regulations or guidelines issued under such acts.</u>
- 21 (b) Such appropriations authorization shall provide a maximum amount of 138 percent of
- 22 <u>the federal poverty level."</u>

SECTION 3.

24 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
