- 10 Code section to read as follows:
- 11 "43-34-22.1.
- 12 (a) No physician shall advertise or hold himself or herself out to the public in any manner
- as being certified or board certified in any specialty or subspecialty by a public or private
- board, including, but not limited to, a multidisciplinary board, unless:
- 15 (1) The advertisement or publication states the full name of the certifying board; and
- 16 (2) Such certifying board either:
- 17 (A) Is a member board of the American Board of Medical Specialties or the American
- 18 <u>Osteopathic Association; or</u>
- 19 (B) Requires successful completion of a postgraduate training program approved by
- 20 <u>the Accreditation Commission for Graduate Medical Education or the American</u>
- 21 Osteopathic Association that provides complete training in the specialty or subspecialty
- 22 <u>certified, followed by prerequisite certification by the American Board of Medical</u>
- 23 Specialties or the American Osteopathic Association board for that training field, and
- 24 <u>further successful completion of an examination in the specialty or subspecialty</u>
- certified.
